**"DO's and DON'Ts of
Hearing Aids"**

DO's

- ▶ Place the hearing aids in the dry aid box/ dehumidifier box (white colour box) every night. This will keep the hearing aid dry and protected from moisture.



- ▶ Store the hearing aids in a cool, dry place when it is not in use.



- ▶ When the hearing aid is removed/ not in use, switch it off. This helps save battery.

- ▶ Always handle the hearing aids gently and with care to avoid damage.

- ▶ Always remember to remove the hearing aids before bathing, going to sleep, or if it starts raining, to prevent damage.



- ▶ Keep your ear dry and clean.

- ▶ Check opening of ear mould/ wax guard of hearing aid for wax before wearing it.



DON'Ts

- ▶ Don't drop it: Do not drop the hearing aids, it may cause permanent damage.



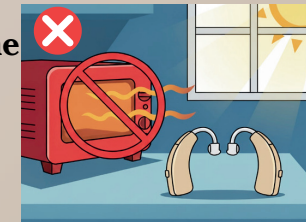
- ▶ Don't pull hard: Be gentle with the mould or wires; avoid twisting or pulling them.

- ▶ Do not use cleaning sprays, hair oils, or similar products near the hearing aids.

- ▶ Do not wear the hearing aids if you have ear pain or ear discharge. Immediately consult an ENT doctor.



- ▶ Away from heat/sun: Do not keep the hearing aids near other electronics that generate heat or in direct sunlight.



- ▶ No water: Never immerse the hearing aids in water.
